Supporting Children With Specific Learning Difficulties (Dyslexia): A Course For Classroom Assistants

Cwrs dwyieithog 30 awr yw hwn a fydd o ddiddordeb i holl gynorthwywyr dosbarth, cynorthwywyr dysgu, cynorthwywyr cefnogi dysgu a chynorthwywyr athrawon sy'n gweithio yn Gymraeg a Saesneg.

Amcanion y modiwl yw:

- Rhoi dealltwriaeth o'r prif faterion yn ymwneud â dyslecsia
- Rhoi gwybodaeth am y problemau y mae disgyblion â dyslecsia yn eu wynebu ac adnabod ffyrdd y mae plant o'r fath yn datgelu'r anawsterau hynny
- Edrych ar wahanol ddulliau o ddysgu plant â dyslecsia
- Gwella gwybodaeth am swyddogaeth gweithwyr proffesiynol ategol a'r amrywiaeth o adnoddau sydd ar gael i gynorthwyo i ddysgu plant â dyslecsia
- Datblygu sgiliau i greu gemau ac adnoddau dysgu ym meysydd llythrennedd a rhifedd
- Codi ymwybyddiaeth o agweddau perthnasol allweddol ar y Cwricwlwm Cenedlaethol a chod ymarfer.

This is a 30 hour bilingual course which will be of interest to all classroom assistants, teaching assistants, learning support assistants and teacher's aides working in English or Welsh.

The aims of the module are to:

- Provide an understanding of the key issues related to dyslexia
- Provide information about the problems faced by pupils with dyslexia and to recognise ways in which such children reveal such difficulties.
- Examine the different approaches to teaching children with dyslexia
- Improve knowledge of the role and function of support professionals and the range of resources available to support the teaching of children with dyslexia
- Develop skills in creating learning games and resources in the areas of literacy and numeracy
- Raise awareness of relevant key aspects of the National Curriculum and code of practice

Rhoddir y cwrs gan diwtoriaid arbenigol mewn dyslecsia o'r Ganolfan Dyslecsia Miles ym Mhrifysgol Bangor. Mae wedi ei achredu gan y Brifysgol trwy'r Ysgol Addysg a Dysgu Gydol Oes ar gyfer 20 credyd ar Lefel 4 (yr un lefel ag NVQ Lefel4/Lefel 4 Israddedig).

Ar ôl ei gwblhau'n llwyddiannus bydd myfyrwyr yn cyflawni'r meini prawf ar gyfer Tystysgrif mewn Anawsterau Dysgu Penodol ar gyfer Cynorthwywyr Dosbarth, a byddant yn gallu gwneud cais am hon i'r British Dyslexia Association (BDA).

LLE DYSGIR Y CWRS?

Cynhelir y cwrs ar Safle'r Normal, Ysgol Addysg a Dysgu Gydol Oes, Prifysgol Bangor, LL57 2PZ.

The course is delivered by specialist dyslexia tutors from the Miles Dyslexia Centre at Bangor University, and is accredited by the University through the School of Education and Lifelong Learning for 20 credits at Level 4 (learning is at the same level as NVQ Level 4/Undergraduate Level 4).

Upon successful completion of the module students will meet the criteria for the Certificate for Classroom Assistants in Specific Learning Difficulties (ALSA), and they will be able to apply to the British Dyslexia Association (BDA) for this.
